The academic program includes honors and advanced placement courses in history, math, science, and English. Language support and regular mainstreamed classes, as well as Advanced Placement and Honors, are scheduled after testing when international students arrive. Eight language-support classes, developed after the Cognitive Academic Language Learning Approach, are provided if needed. Students are taught to think critically and to develop analytical skills that will prepare them for life beyond high school. The goal is for each student to be spiritually, academically, and socially prepared for the world before them, and ultimately to prepare students who are academically and spiritually prepared to be an asset in their community and to the people close to them.
