The Upper Division at Garden School encompasses grades 7–12. The classes are small, averaging 15 students, yet it is not only our small class size that defines Garden but also the atmosphere within those classes. High school classes provide students with the opportunity to have interpersonal relationships with their teachers, individual attention and mentoring, and meaningful educational experiences. The academic plan for students includes study of the five major academic disciplines—(English, social studies/history, mathematics, science, and foreign language) our detailed and targeted college planning program.
