Sutton Park School is chiefly an academic school, with over 95% of its graduates going on to third level institutions, including major universities in Ireland, Europe and North America. Sutton Park is well known for its programmes in Music, Drama and Fine Art.

Sutton Park's facilities consist of an imposing Georgian house, modern classroom blocks, two science laboratories, a modern gymnasium, a heated outdoor swimming pool and outstanding grass and AstroTurf sports pitches. As part of their on-going Development Programme, they have recently opened new €7.5 million facilities, including a brand new library and information technology centre.

Sutton Park recognises that each pupil has individual needs and abilities, and that each develops at a different rate. The School aims to meet the needs and foster the abilities of each one. The School aims to give each student, irrespective of personal preference, an appreciation of the natural sciences, the social sciences, the humanities, languages and the arts and to develop in each student knowledge and skills in all these areas commensurate with their talents and abilities. Similarly, through a structured programme of health and physical education and a variety of team and individual sporting activities, the School aims to promote the physical well-being of its pupils and the development of personal skills and team spirit.

The senior curriculum follows closely that issued by the Irish Department of Education for secondary schools. Where possible, the curriculum shows an awareness of developments and trends in international education.

B. Academic excellence within the parameters of individual ability is a priority. Adequate provision of scholarship assistance with an appropriate monitoring system is envisaged.

C. The curriculum in each subject area reflects a coherent orderly progression through the grades.
